The Huntington Beach Union High School District schools (Huntington Beach, Westminster, Marina, Fountain Valley, Edison, Ocean View, Valley Vista, Coast and Adult School, and Community Day School) are known for their commitment to academic excellence for all students in the communities they serve. In addition to the wide array of academic offerings at all comprehensive campuses, designated schools have established a variety of specialized programs to enhance student success. These programs include Model United Nations (MUN); Academy for the Performing Arts (APA); International Baccalaureate (IB); Math Educational Resources Integrated with Technology and Science (MERITS); Advancement Via Individualized Determination (AVID); Center for International Business and Communication Studies (CIBACS); and Entertainment and Tourism, Business and Health Academics.

In addition, the HBUHSD has gained notoriety for providing a full spectrum of special programs and alternative settings for students with Individualized Education Plans (IEPs). With programs like the Special Abilities Cluster (SAC), Pathways and Endeavors, students with special needs have the opportunity to receive instruction in accordance with their individual needs and to participate in activities a comprehensive school site has to offer.

CALIFORNIA ACCOUNTABILITY PROGRAM

The California Department of Education has set a target for all schools to achieve a score of 800 on their Academic Performance Index (API) and to show growth each year. Results from the Standardized Testing and Reporting (STAR) and the California High School Exit Exam (CAHSEE) are used to calculate the API. The STAR and CAHSEE measure student achievement of the California Standards Tests in English, math, history/social science and in science. Several schools from the HBUHSD outperform the state average of schools demonstrating student and teacher commitment to academic excellence.

COLLEGE ADMISSION/ADVANCED PLACEMENT EXAMS

The HBHUSD schools traditionally do an outstanding job of preparing students for post-secondary education. Enrollment in college preparatory classes and scoring well on college entrance exams give students an edge in college admissions. Test scores for the district class of 2008 are 101 points above the national average for the SAT Reasoning Test, and 3.1 points above the national average for the ACT. Over \$18,000,000 in scholarships was offered to the Class of 2009.

In May 2009, 2,800 AP exams received scores of 3, 4, or 5, the level recognized by universities as deserving of degree credit. The number of passing AP scores in the district is equivalent in size to 37% of the combined total enrollment of juniors and seniors.

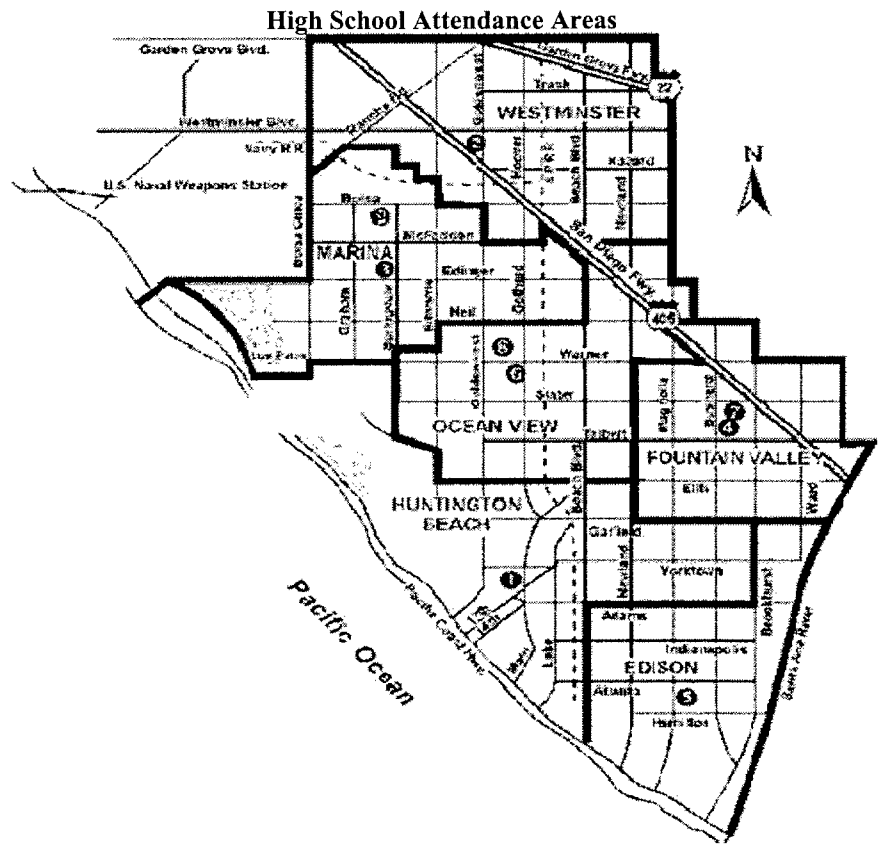
